

## Pastels

A variety of colors, from warm to cool, and darkest to lightest, brights and greys (greys are not literal greys but muted colors). At least 60 and preferably more, in different levels of hardness.

Peel paper off prior to the workshop.

## Approved papers

**Size: 9 x 12 or 11 x 14**

- Pastel Matt in a warm color such as Sienna - *I use this.*
- \_\_\_ Pastel Premier in a warm color such as Terra Cotta - *I use this.*
- \_\_\_ Ampersand sanded pastelboard in a warm color - *I don't use this.*
- \_\_\_ **Please no white sanded paper, if you have white please pre-tone it before the class in a warm tone.**
- **If you use U-Art please pre tone at home. Otherwise no white paper.**
- **Paper NOT approved: No unsanded paper, No MiTientes**

## Recommended Pastels

- A brown pastel pencil for drawing
- \_\_\_ A few hard NuPastels: Recommended 305 Spruce Blue, a warm tone such as a burnt umber or burnt sienna, an ochre or yellow such as Light Ochre 243 and a pink such as Orchid Pink 306, light blue, bright yellow,
- \_\_\_ **Hard pastels for first layers**, Nu Pastel, student grade soft pastels, Rembrandt.
- \_\_\_ **Soft pastels for top layers**: Sennelier, Jack Richeson, Diane Tousand, Art spectrum extra soft, Great American, Mount Vision, Terry Ludwig - Recommended starter set is Paris Collection or similar.
- \_\_\_ Please know that student grade pastels that are called "soft pastels" are really not soft and are hard.
- \_\_\_ Minimum of 60 soft pastels.

## Backboard

A small board larger than the paper to mount the paper.

## Tape

White artist tape: 3/4" with okay (*for mounting paper to back board*).

## Sketching

- \_\_\_ Small sketchbook or paper (*grey paper is preferred*).
- \_\_\_ A couple of markers, black and grey
- \_\_\_ Pencil is also okay

## Cleaning Supplies

- \_\_\_ Paper towels or small microfiber cloth (*I use the microfiber cloth because it's washable and there is no waste*)
- \_\_\_ A small pack of wet wipes or diaper wipes to clean your hands. (*I use diaper wipes by Seven Generations. They are biodegradable and don't contain parabens.*)
- A small bag for trash

Lanza Gallery & Art Supplies carries many of the supplies with a 20% student discount for all taking the workshop.
